Scholarship Aptitude Test (SAT) Registration:
Register for and take the Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) of the College Board no later than the December administration. When completing the reports to Colleges and Scholarship Sponsors Section, Item 14, Side 2 of your Registration Form, enter Code 0095 for the ITPE John F. Conley-Happy I. Franklin Scholarship Program as one of the colleges or scholarship programs to which scores are to be sent.

NOTE: *If this instruction is not followed accurately, the scores will not be reported and you will be declared ineligible.* To register for the November or December SAT or ACT you will need a copy of the College Board Admission Testing Program *Student Bulletin*. Obtain the *Student Bulletin* early because there are registration deadlines. Walk-in registration may be available at the Test Center, but it is not guaranteed.

Students who have taken the SAT at an earlier time are not required to take the test again. In order to have scores from an earlier administration of the SAT reported, submit an Additional Report Request Form available at your high school. Fill in the Code Number 0095 for the ITPE John F. Conley-Happy I. Franklin Scholarship Program Item 8 on Side 1 and send the form no later than December 1st with the appropriate fee to The College Board Admissions Testing Program according to instructions in the *Student Bulletin*.

No special test is required of applicants for the vocational/technical awards of the ITPE John F. Conley-Happy I. Franklin Scholarship Programs. Each eligible applicant will be sent several forms to be completed. These forms request biographical information from the applicant, and information on high school performance to be supplied by the applicant's high school. Also, each applicant for a vocational/technical award will be asked to name the institution he or she plans to attend. The applicant is urged to visit (if possible) the schools being considered and to obtain a copy of the official school bulletin and course outlines.

CALENDAR OF EVENTS

SEPTEMBER

Scholarship Program is announced. Brochures and applications available at ITPE Branch offices and the ITPE John F. Conley-Happy I. Franklin Plan Office, Savannah, Georgia.

DECEMBER

Candidates submit applications to ETS by December 1st. Eligible candidates are sent Biographical Questionnaires. Secondary School Reports and Institution Choice forms.

JANUARY

Candidates and schools return completed forms.

FEBRUARY - APRIL

Scholarship Committee evaluates each candidate's credentials and select winners. Winners are announced.

NOTE: Only SAT scores are acceptable. Since test scores are used in the selection procedure, all scholarship applicants are required to submit SAT scores. Without scores it will be necessary to disqualify the applicant.
